BAPTISM:

Arrangements must be made at the Rectory. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. Parents, and also godparents when possible, must attend the Pre-Baptismal conference which is held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:30pm in the rectory.

CONFESSIONS:

Saturday afternoons 4:30 to 5:15 pm, and anytime at the Rectory.

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance at the rectory to ensure the date and the hour desired. The Nuptial Mass is the ordinary form of celebrating Christian marriage, and should be strongly considered when making Wedding plans. Attendance at the Pre-Cana Conferences, or the equivalent, is required by the Archbishop.

Central Park West to the Hudson River, from the South side of 77th Street down to the North side of 65th Street.

NEW PARISHIONERS:

We welcome new parishioners, and invite them to register at the Rectory. The registration is our only means of certifying anyone as a member of our parish. If you move to another Parish, or change your address within the Parish, please notify us.

FATIMA DEVOTIONS:

The Rosary is said daily after the 12:10 pm Mass. Friday from 6-7 pm there is a holy hour.

BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:

First Friday - Exposition: 12:35 pm.

Adoration: All day; Benediction: 5:15 PM.

MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA:

Mondays, before the 12:10 Mass and before the 5:30 pm Mass.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS:

Classes in Religion for Catholic children/teenagers, Pre-kindergarten - High School take place on Sundays. The Family Mass begins at 10:00 a.m. in the Church followed by class instruction in the school.

Ongoing religious education is important for the religious development of your children. A child must have at least one year of religious instruction before enrolling in the First Communion or Confirmation class.

PARISH NEWS

My dear parishioners and friends,

May is the month of Mary. The rosary is prayed everyday after the 12:10 pm Mass, perhaps you might wish to join.

This first week of May we celebrate the feast of three of the saints of the church. Tuesday, May 2nd, we celebrate the feast of Saint Athanasius, the bishop of Alexandria and a doctor of the church, he contributed immensely in the areas of doctrine and spirituality.

On Wednesday, May 3 we celebrate the feast of the Apostles, Philip and James. Little is known of them.... both died as martyrs, shedding their blood for the sake of the Gospel. They are most likely celebrated together because the Basilica of the Twelve Apostles in Rome is dedicated to them.

On Tuesday of this week, May 2nd, at 7:30 pm in the rectory, parents who wish to present their child for Baptism are expected to attend the Baptismal Preparation Program. God parents are encouraged to attend.....

The Blessed Sacrament School and Sunday School parents all received a letter earlier this week regarding some necessary work that is taking place in the school building this weekend. Earlier in the month, two classrooms were affected by a leak from a drainpipe in the roof. Both classrooms were shut down after the leak and will reopen once the restoration work is complete. Our insurance company has been helping coordinate the clean-up and restoration effort. This effort has had several stages: removal of surface material was extended to the walls and ceilings wherever they tested positive for moisture content beyond the visible damage; mold remediation and drying specialists were then sent in to prepare for the restoration work. As things began to dry, a few floor tiles in Room 404 began to buckle. As in most old school buildings, those floor tiles contain asbestos, and that entire classroom floor must now be replaced, following all of the necessary protocols of asbestos abatement. Because of the size of the floor, the school building had to be shut down, this weekend, for the abatement. This is a project done by professional vendors with all of the necessary permits in place, and air monitors on the scene for the duration of the abatement. Sunday School and the Sunday Soup Kitchen will be closed this weekend, and will reopen on May 7.

Next Saturday, May 6th, the 7:30 am and 12:10 pm Masses will be celebrated in the rectory.....a baptism will be celebrated in the Church at 11:30 am.....The Church building will re-open at 4:30 pm, in time for confessions and the 5:30 pm Mass. In the past year, because of the location and beauty of our church, we have received many requests to film in the Church building. Given the delicate nature of the content of some shows, as well as our very busy parish calendar, this is the first request we can accommodate. The title of the show is "Elementary" and the parish will receive \$25,000.00.....I thank you in advance for your co-operation.

Also, while the church's exterior restoration work officially began several weeks ago, these past few weeks have been spent with the architect and contractor submitting more samples of stone and mortar to the New York City Landmarks Preservation Commission for approval. Finally this past week our contractors have been able to start cutting out the mortar joints on the west side bricks of the building in preparation for their repointing. Work on the east wall of the church begins this coming week.

I would like to say thank-you, once again, to each and every member of the parish who has pledged to support this effort in the capital campaign. If you have not yet been able to make pledge, I would ask

you please to pray about how you might be able to support this effort. And again, thank-you!

Let us keep praying for peace.....

Mayo es el mes de Maria. Rezamos el rosario todos los días después de la Misa de las 12:10pm. Si así lo desean, pueden acompañarnos.

En la primera semana de mayo celebramos la fiesta de tres santos de la Iglesia. El martes, día 2, la Fiesta de San Atanasio, Obispo de Alejandría, quien contribuyo enormemente en las areas de la doctrina y la espiritualidad.

El 3 de mayo celebramos la Fiesta de los Apóstoles Felipe y Santiago. Muy poco se sabe de ellos...ambos fueron mártires derramando su sangre por el bien del Evangelio. Se celebran juntos ya que la Basílica de los Doce Apóstoles en Roma esta dedicada a ellos.

Los padres presentando a sus hijos/as para el Sacramento del Bautismo deberán asistir al programa de preparación el martes, 2 de mayo a las 7:30pm en la Rectoría. También los padrinos serán bienvenidos...

Los padres de los alumnos de la escuela Blessed Sacrament así como los padres de los alumnos en nuestro "Sunday School" recibieron esta semana una carta describiendo unos trabajos necesarios en el edificio de la escuela durante este fin de semana. Dos de las aulas de la escuela fueron afectadas por un desague en el techo. Ambas aulas fueron cerradas y reabrirán una vez concluyan los trabajos. Nuestra aseguradora está ayudando a coordinar este esfuerzo el cual tiene lugar en varias fases: removiendo el material exterior de las paredes y techos donde dio positivo el contenido de humedad; especialistas en el manejo de moho y en humedad fueron enviados a preparar el area para el trabajo. Cuando el area empezó a secarse algunos mosaicos en el Aula 404 comenzaron a doblarse. Como en la mayoría de los edificios escolares viejos, estos mosaicos contienen asbestos, y el piso completo de esta aula debe ser reemplazado siguiendo los protocolos necesarios para la eliminación de este material. Por la magnitud de este trabajo el edificio tiene que mantenerse cerrado este fin de semana. Profesionales en ese campo están trabajando en este proyecto con todos los permisos necesarios y controlando la calidad del aire durante este proceso. Este fin de semana tanto el Comedor Social ("Soup Kitchen") y el "Sunday School" estarán cerrados y reabrirán el domingo 7 de mayo.

El proximo sábado, 6 de mayo, las Misas de las 7:30am y 12:10pm serán celebradas en la Rectoría...un Bautismo tendrá lugar en la Iglesia a las 11:30am...La iglesia reabrirá a las 4:30pm para confesiones y la Misa de la 5:30pm. Ultimamente, por nuestra ubicación y por la belleza de nuestra iglesia, hemos recibido muchos pedidos para grabar dentro del recinto. Dado que algunos shows son de un contenido delicado así como que nuestro calendario está muy lleno, esta es la primera vez que podemos acomodarlos. El titulo del show es "Elementary" y la parroquia recibirá \$25,000...Les agradezco, por adelantado, su comprensión.
