The Nuptial Mass is the ordinary form of celebrating Christian marriage, and should be strongly considered when making Wedding plans. Attendance at the Pre-Cana Conferences, or the equivalent, is required by the Archbishop.

#### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends;

This week I'd like to bring you up to date on all the many construction and repair projects going on in the parish.

The plans for our largest project, the repair of the façade, are before the Landmarks Commission and should be approved shortly and we'll begin as soon as possible. We won't know the extant of the problems until we have the scaffolding up and engineers have a look. I'll keep you posted.

We've also undertaken the renovation and repair of the theater and the church undercroft. I'm told we should have an Assembly Permit soon. Both spaces will be splendid when finished. The bathrooms have been cleaned and fixed, the back hall cleared of all debris. As I write, new exit doors are being installed, and old doors are being repaired and refurbished. The floors are gleaming and soon our team will skim coat the walls and put on a coat of primer.

In the course of working on the undercroft, we became aware of a corroded and damaged pipe that allowed water to pour in through a window onto the floor of the undercroft, causing significant damage to the wooden floor over the years. To fix the problem, our beautiful courtyard had to be torn up and new piping put down.

Since we are responsible for the general upkeep of the school building, we were notified by the city that our two huge water tanks needed to be drained, cleaned and inspected. This has taken place and we passed our inspection.

I know there are other things that I'm forgetting, but suffice to say, a lot of work has been accomplished this summer, and a lot of work will continue on through the colder months. Thanks for your patience.

Esta semana quiero informarles sobre los proyectos de construcción que se están llevando a cabo en nuestra parroquia.

Los planos para el proyecto mas grande, reparar la fachada, están siendo revisados por el "Landmarks Commission". Esperamos sean aprobados en cualquier momento y el trabajo comenzara inmediatamente. Al momento no sabemos exactamente la magnitud de los problemas hasta que el andamio sea instalado y los ingenieros puedan evaluarlos. Les mantendré informados.

Igualmente se esta efectuando la renovación y reparación del teatro y del sótano. Nos han informado que recibiremos pronto el permiso para reuniones. Se están instalando puertas nuevas de salida ("exit") el piso está brillante y nuestro equipo pintara las paredes en unos días.

Mientras se hacían estas reparaciones descubrimos que unas tuberías estaban oxidadas causando que el agua entrara al sótano lo cual causo considerable daño al piso a través de l tiempo. Para arreglar este problema el patio tuvo que ser excavado y nueva tubería instalada.

Y como somos responsables del mantenimiento de la escuela, la ciudad nos informo que los tanques de agua necesitaban ser vaciados, limpiados e inspeccionados. Ya se ha hecho y hemos pasado la inspección.

Se que me he olvidados de otras cosas, pero si les puedo decir que mucho trabajo ha tenido lugar este verano y que el trabajo continuara a través de los meses mas fríos. Roguemos por la Paz.
